When I read fake news, I just ignore them.

I just ignore fake news when I read them.

When we are talking about things that are generally true, especially laws and rules we use **conditional type zero** or **zero condition**.

Zero Conditional

If I use my mobile phone for too long at night, I can't sleep.

'When' can also be used.

use - Present Simple
can't - Present Simple
